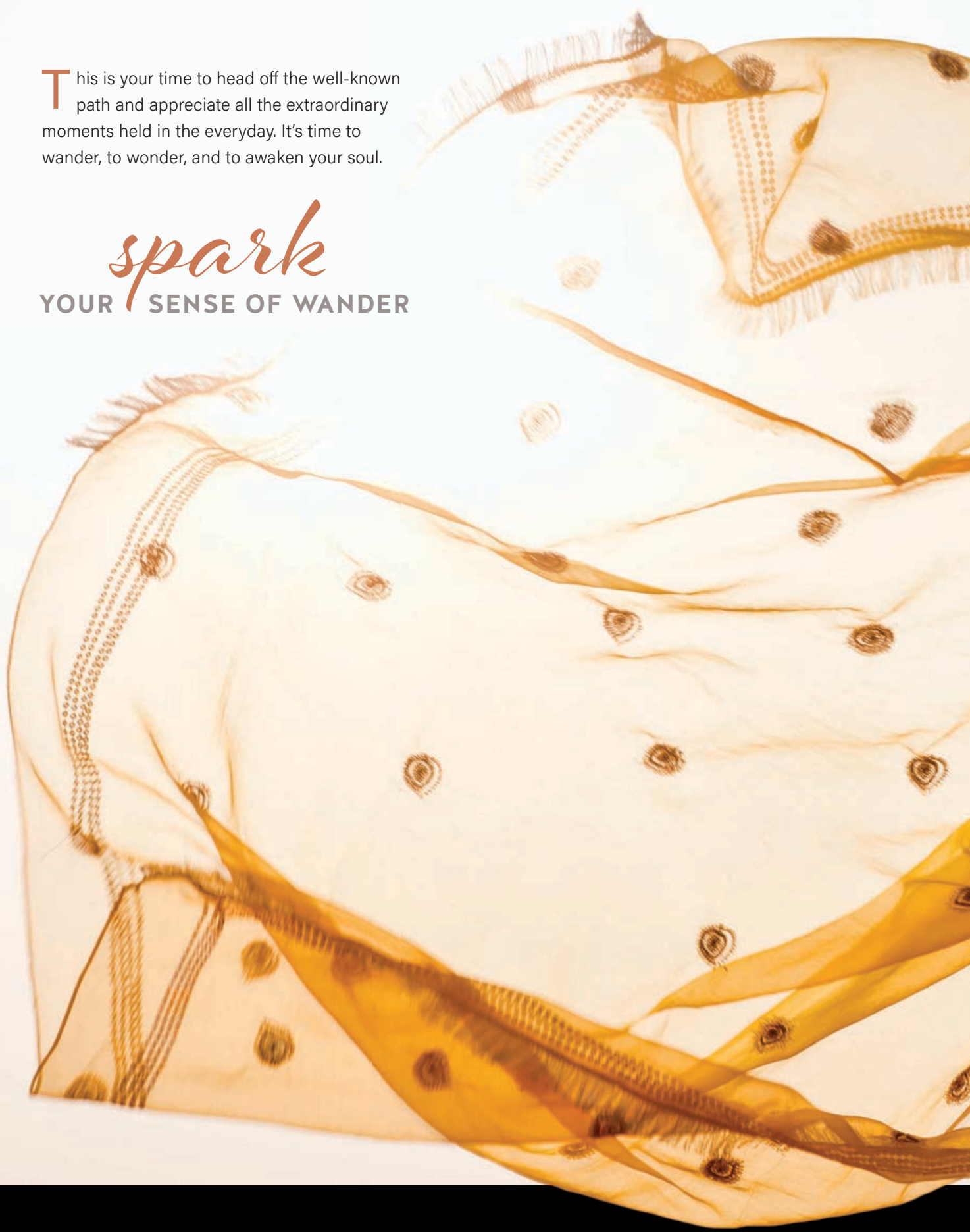

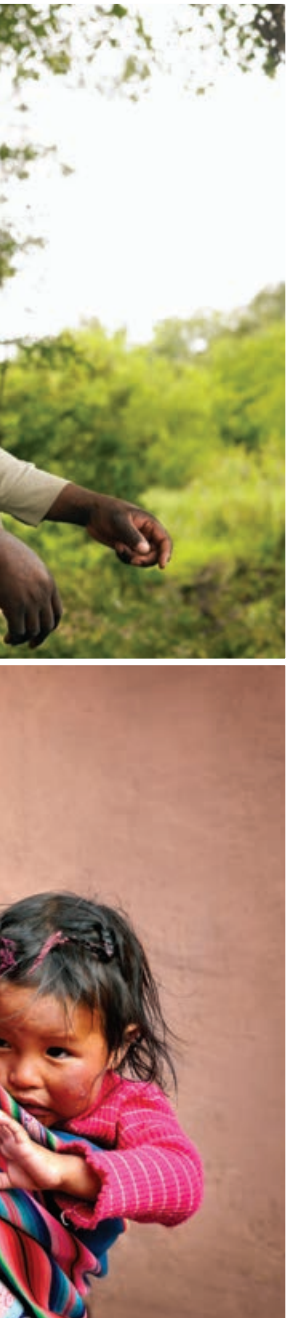

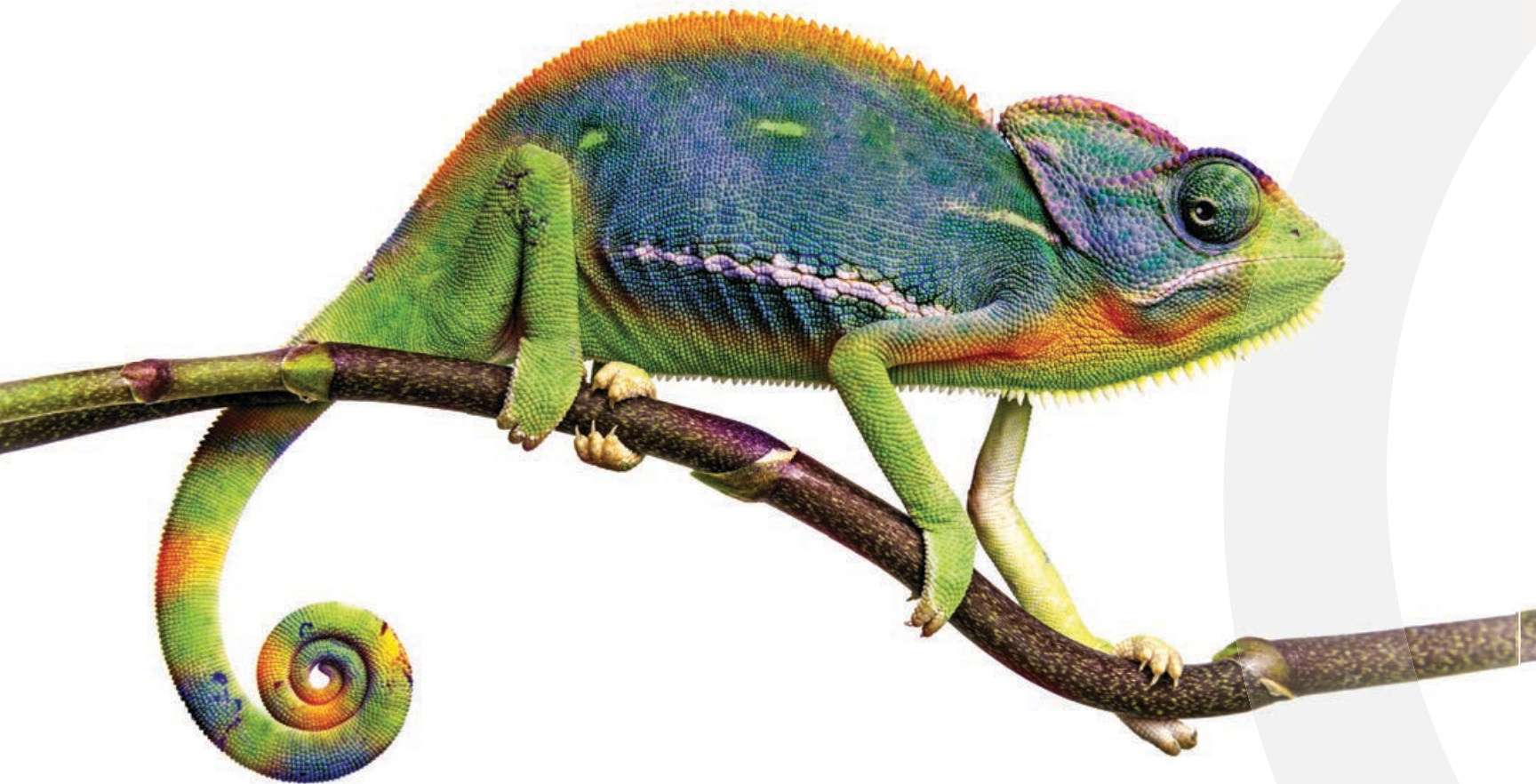

HOW AN ADVENTURER

FELL IN LOVE WITH DOGS
(AND REINDEER) IN FINLAND

While on **The Northern Lights of Finland** tour, Collette's Art Director discovered that dogs are pretty amazing and that reindeer really are magical. Here, Chad Litchfield tells the tale of how animals brought experiencing the natural wonders of Finland to another level.



I'm a bit of a thrill seeker.

I like speed and even a little danger, so when I learned that we would be going on a husky safari and a reindeer sleigh ride, I wasn't prepared for what was to come. It all sounded like fun, but my natural inclination would have been to hop on a snowmobile. I'm glad I didn't because these experiences turned out to be totally exhilarating in ways I didn't expect.

Before we set out to dash through the rugged Lapland wilderness, we got a chance to meet the dogs who would be pulling our sleds. We were greeted with sloppy kisses and wagging tails all around from dogs who were clearly up for an adventure. I even got to hold a wiggly little husky puppy. I was falling in love with the dogs, but this was just the beginning.

Once I was on that sled, I had a huge smile on my face as I led my team zig zagging through the snow. This is clearly what the dogs live for and it is absolutely the best way to experience the wilderness. But then I met the reindeer,

and I realized there are two best ways. Another part of The Northern Lights of Finland tour is going out at night for a reindeer sleigh ride. Eating dinner just a short distance away from the reindeer enclosure, we were able to anticipate our introduction to the calm and gentle animals. This was clearly going to be a different experience from the blood pumping exuberance of the husky safari, but equally intriguing.

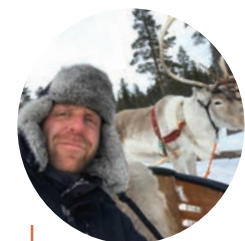
The reindeer and sleigh provided a relaxed and gentle glide through the snow. It was so silent and still beneath the vast night sky that I had time to contemplate how humble I felt in that moment. But all of that tranquility was punctuated with a giant exclamation point when the elusive northern lights suddenly appeared and danced through the sky like silent fireworks. I could never have anticipated the joy and connectedness to nature that I felt as the faithful reindeer kept their easy pace, unaffected by their surroundings. I was blown away.

After these two magical experiences, I can honestly say that dogs and reindeer are my new favourite ways to get around. **Now if I could only fit them into my suitcase...**

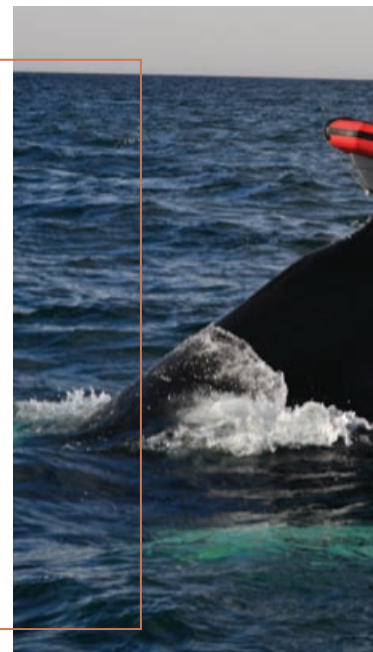

THE LEGEND OF THE ARAN SWEATER

Set along the Wild Atlantic Way on the western coast of Ireland are the Aran Islands – a trio of limestone isles that seemingly remain untouched by the hands of time. From ancient stone fortresses that stand defiantly atop dramatic cliffs, to weather-beaten homes inhabited by humble farm folk, the Islands are a storybook setting for the centuries-old maritime legends and Celtic myths born from its windswept shores.

One such legend that's been passed down for generations is the origin of the Aran Islands sweater. Depending on who you ask, the storied sweater is an homage to centuries-old Celtic settlers, a religious garment worn to protect fishermen from the perils of sailing the Atlantic, or a creatively woven tale aimed at putting Aran Islands on the map. So, what was the true motivation behind the first stitch?

The majority of historians agree that the Aran sweater was invented in the beginning of the 20th century, and was an adaptation of Scottish Guernsey jumpers, or "Guernseys." The women of the Islands put their own spin on the sweater design, using thicker wool and patterns that completely covered the sweater. Knitting the sweaters turned from a

crafty pastime to a source of revenue, as the garments were sold to tourists in Dublin and by the 1950s, worldwide.

Capitalizing on this popularity, English yarn shop owner Heinz Edgar Kiewe made the claim that the sweater's intricate patterns held deeper religious meanings. Clever marketing also perpetuated the myth that particular patterns were linked to certain families, and that these stitches helped identify sailors who washed ashore after losing a battle with the sea.

During your stay in Inisheer- the smallest of the three mystical Aran Islands-you'll partake in a knitting workshop where you'll learn about the traditional methods used to make the Aran sweater. As you discover the garment's intricate stitch-work, you'll be in on one of the Islands' greatest sartorial secrets.

A STORY FOR EVERY STITCH

HONEYCOMB

Represents the industrious honey bee. This stitch symbolized hard work – a virtue the Aran Islands' natives valued.

BASKET

Symbolizes the fisherman's basket and hopes for a bountiful catch.

TREE OF LIFE

Also known as the Trinity Stitch, said to symbolize the strong ties of family and the desire for familial unity.

CABLE & ROPE

A popular, commonly seen stitch. Represents the fisherman's rope – said to bring good luck and safety.

MOSS-FILLED DIAMOND

Represents the Carrageen Moss seaweed – an important fertilizer that helped the natives' crops grow. Symbolizes fertile fields and abundant growth.

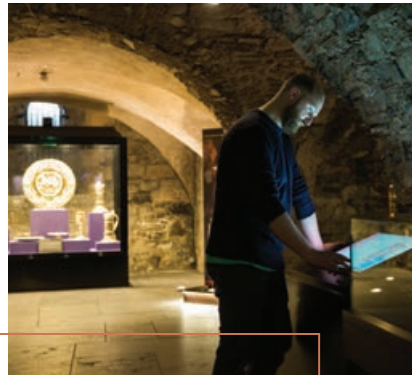

A TRIP DESIGNER SHARES HER *secrets*

Recently, our own **Diana Ditto**, Director of Product Design, sat down with AFAR magazine to dish about her day job—travelling the world to research and craft travel experiences for our guests. Read an excerpt here and see the full interview at [AFAR.com](https://www.afar.com).

WHAT DOES A TYPICAL DAY IN THE LIFE OF A DESIGN MANAGER LOOK LIKE WHEN YOU ARE EXPLORING NEW ITINERARIES/DESTINATIONS?

As a design manager, we are constantly researching new and unique experiences, restaurants, and hotels. We don't want to be like every other tour operator. Our goal is to handcraft bespoke experiences and to move away from ones that are so commercialized they've lost their uniqueness. Tour designers spend 100+ days on the road each year, sourcing the best for our travellers. Our designers also find unique accommodations—castles, igloos, Bedouin camps—that guests can't book on their own. We introduce our guests to local people and local cultures, we don't just stare at them from a distance. But all this takes a tremendous amount of preparation and research, visiting countless restaurants or cooking schools to find the perfect one.

WHAT TYPES OF EXPERIENCES AND ACCOMMODATIONS CAN AN EXPLORATIONS TRAVELLER EXPECT?

On an Explorations tour, guests will find themselves going beyond surface level experiences. Accompanying a chef to a local market and preparing a meal using the freshest ingredients. They will see the must-sees, but also the incredible natural landscapes, architectural

wonders, and historic landmarks that evoke a sense of awe. And the best part is that guests will do all of this with exceptional access due to the small size of the groups—an average of 15 travellers.

WHAT DOES EXPLORATIONS OFFER THAT OTHER TOUR COMPANIES DON'T?

After speaking with various travel professionals and conducting extensive research we identified a gap in the competitive landscape of small group tours. We are designing itineraries that include all the things people want to do, but may be afraid to do on their own. I was recently in Old Delhi in India and knew I wanted to try some street food—it's so famous and said to be some of the best cooking in the world. I was petrified, however, of picking the wrong vendor and getting sick. We spent two days sourcing vendors and experiences for our street food tour, and the result is incredible. There are many times where I see tourists, longing to participate in an activity, but really struggling with how they would go about arranging something like this. Explorations solves this issue, and more, by allowing guests to see and do things they had only dreamed about.

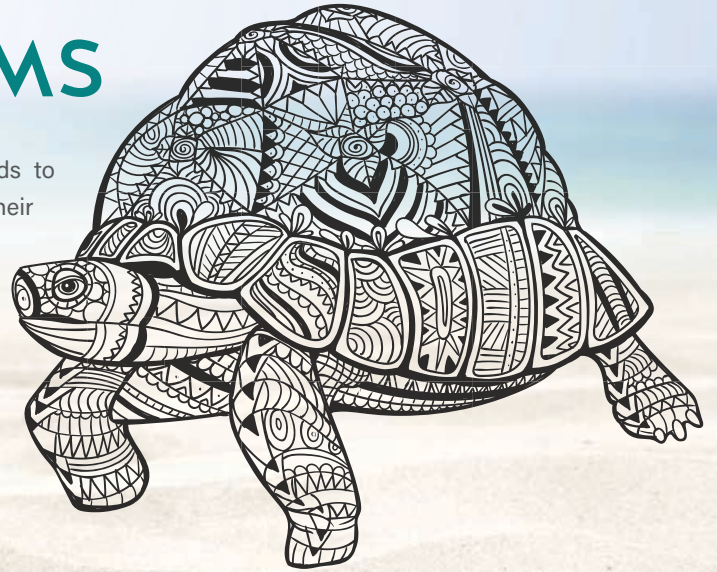

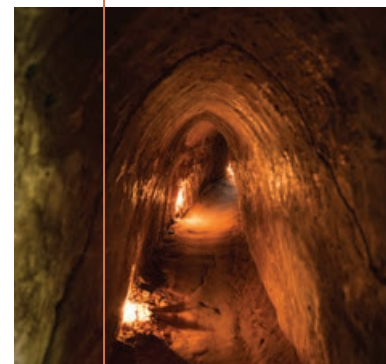

If you really want to experience the thrill of this corner of India's capital, the preferred way to do it is by rickshaw.

India's most popular way of getting around holds a certain edge here in Old Delhi; a new thrill with every dodge of a car, cow, motorbike, or another rickshaw.

Rolling alongside buildings stacked beside pagodas, you'll hop on, hop off, and eat as the locals do. Inside the din of Old Delhi, the senses are filled with smells of curry and chapatti, lights almost as bright as the Lane of Spices, and the stereo surround of honking horns and conversations turned up to eleven. But in the thick of what looks like madness, the flow of the journey is orchestrated chaos.

Hit up the street stalls filled with Chana masala, goat curry, kofta, and dahl, and walk among the crowds lining the sidewalks beside cauldrons of biryani and flaming kebabs. Devour butter chicken

roasted over open flames and drenched in ghee and immerse yourself in the crowd as it rings around deep pans where balls of dough fry in to hot bubble bread the size of a small balloon.

As you maneuver past a 200-year-old store selling incense, stop at a spot serving fried chicken and happiness for more than forty-five years. There's always room for dessert, even here in Old Delhi. Back on the rickshaw, it's time to follow the sweet scent of Jalebi—swirling shapes of fried batter, dumped in a vat of sugary syrup. Next, at a Kulfi shop, cleanse the palate with a refreshing mix between sorbet and ice cream, in flavours like mango, saffron, lychee, and even garlic!

Through all of the spices, sauces, samosas, chicken birra, and kulfi, discover the heart of India— exciting, colourful, flavourful, and beautifully chaotic. Old Delhi serves it all up on a platter.

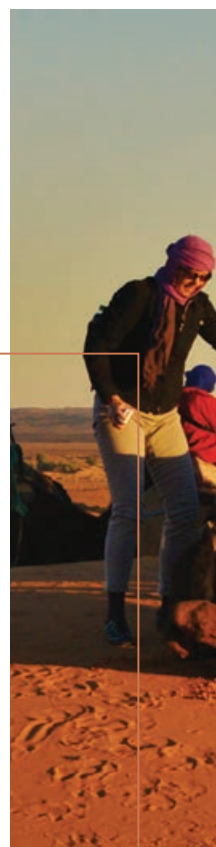

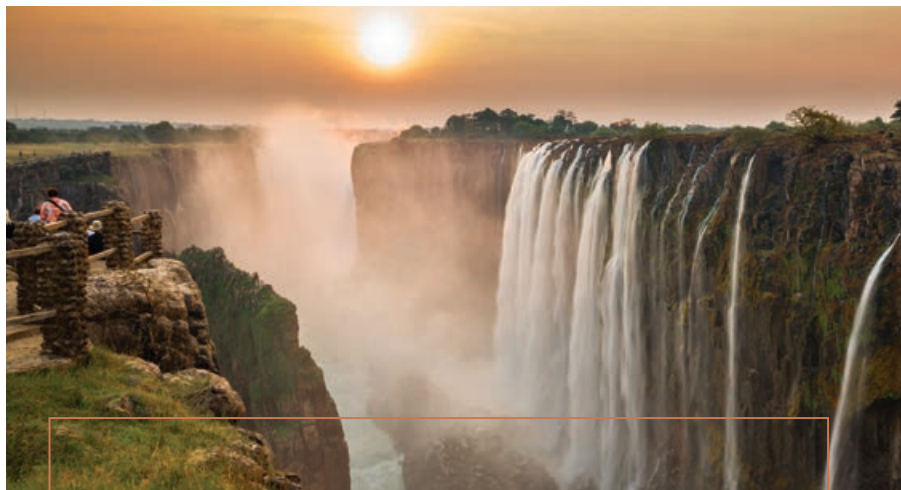

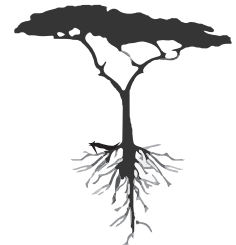

Frequently Asked Questions

Accommodations

What is the difference between a twin room and a double room?

In certain countries, hotel rooms tend to be smaller than Canadian standard accommodations. A double room is designed to accommodate two people, but may not have two separate beds. A twin bedded room has two separate beds of any size, and is the type most commonly utilized.

What size is a triple room? A triple room is the same size as a twin bedded room and beds will accommodate three people, but we cannot guarantee that there will be three separate beds. If there are only two beds, a rollaway may be requested but cannot be guaranteed due to size of room and fire codes. Please inquire at time of reservation.

Can my children travel on tour? Children over the age of 5 may travel on a Collette tour accompanied by an adult. Child land rates are valid for ages 5-12, sharing a room with two full-paying adults.

Are single and triple rooms always available? On many tours, triple and single accommodations are limited and are available on a first come, first served basis. Be advised that single rooms are often smaller.

When can I check into my hotel? Due to early arrival times into some cities, rooms may not always be available for immediate check-in.

Air

Can Collette book our airline reservations? Collette is happy to assist you in accommodating your flight needs. Due to tour scheduling and limited availability, you are strongly encouraged to take advantage of Collette's air packages. We are not responsible for air arrangements you have made on your own. On occasion, it is necessary to change tour dates. In this case, we can only protect air reservations booked through Collette. For all air reservations, it is strongly recommended to reconfirm flights before departure, in the event that the airline has an unexpected schedule change. We cannot assume responsibility for schedule changes, routings or flight cancellations involving the airlines. Not all airlines offer pre-assigned seats. Some charge a fee for seats which will be at the guests' expense. Where pre-assigned seats are not offered, the guests must contact the airline directly to arrange seat assignments.

Attractions & Sightseeing

Are attractions always available? Access to some attractions or Collette Foundation sites may be affected by the observance of holidays, weather conditions or other circumstances. As a result, the days and order of sightseeing may change to best utilize your time on tour. Boat rides are weather permitting. Some attractions may not be available during the "off-season" months. When attractions are unavailable, other similar attractions will be substituted. Wildlife sightings are not guaranteed.

Is there a lot of walking on tour? We pride ourselves on bringing travellers the very best experiences a destination offers. Our itineraries include many activities and may consist of walking on uneven terrain or significant walking at times. Some of the most unique sightseeing can mean accessing locations that restrict motorcoaches, especially in historic areas. Some hotels/lodges in remote locations may not have elevators. For your comfort, we recommend bringing walking shoes. Review each tour's "Tour Activity Level" and "Tour Pacing" (pg 71) for details.

Can you tell me more about the safaris? In order to most fully experience the wildlife, you will be travelling by custom-built safari vehicle which requires climbing in and out frequently and sometimes travels on bumpy roads. To experience Africa fully, we recommend that all travellers be in reasonably good health and prepare properly.

How can I plan for shore landings? Special clothing is required for the shore landings (Antarctica, Galapagos); please refer to your predeparture documents for important details.

Are all theatre performances suitable for children? Some theatre performances may be unsuitable for children – consult your tour manager.

Documentation

Do I need a passport? Government-issued identification is required for all air travel. A valid passport is required for all trips outside Canada. All passengers should check with the appropriate foreign consulate for entry and validity requirements. We recommend that your passport has seven months validity, and at least 3 blank pages. Passports and visas are the responsibility of each client.

In South Africa, children are required to have a passport as well as additional documentation to travel with you into and out of the country. Please consult the South African Embassy for the current specific requirements related to your travel dates.

Extending Your Stay

Can I extend my tour to see more of a region? Yes! You may enhance your tour by purchasing either an extension or pre/post hotel stays, offered on select tours. Extensions may be "hosted" rather than escorted. When hosted, passengers will be greeted upon arrival by a local tour manager who will provide all included services and be available on-call during the duration of the extension. A minimum number of passengers may be required to operate some extensions. Extensions not purchased at time of deposit are subject to availability and applicable charges at time of request.

Collette also offers pre and post hotel nights before and/or after a tour for you to explore the destination independently. Should you purchase additional nights, please be advised that your Tour Manager will not be available during this time.

Extras

What is not included in the tour price? The land price does not include air travel, airline fees, airport or departure taxes, transfers, visas, customary end-of-trip gratuities for your tour manager, driver, local guides, hotel housekeepers, cruise ship waitstaff, and any incidental charges.

Late Bookings

Do you accept late bookings? Tour sales normally close 7 days prior to departure. All late bookings are on request and must be guaranteed with a credit card if within 60 days of departure date.

On-Tour Experience

Where do I meet my Tour Manager? Your tour will begin at your first hotel. The Tour Manager will make contact with you at the hotel and will provide details relating to your tour. The hotel's address and phone number will be included in your documents.

Can I prepurchase optional excursions/activities? Yes, the majority of optional excursions and activities are available for advance purchase for applicable tours provided that you make your options purchase prior to 15 days of the tour departure. Collette makes it convenient to reserve presold options by visiting our website for a full listing of activities and excursions or when your reservation is made with our reservations staff. In addition, there are benefits to prepurchasing options including a price guarantee once your tour is paid in full. So, while the cost of an optional activity may change from the time you book your tour, once payment is received in full, your preselected options are guaranteed by Collette at their original price. Although you can still purchase options while on tour, reserving them ahead of time ensures you a spot in the event that the activity sells out. Collette will provide a refund if you cancel a presold option prior to tour departure. Any presold options cancelled while on tour are nonrefundable.

Revisions/Changes

Would my tour date ever be changed? While it is unlikely, Collette does reserve the right to cancel a tour prior to departure. Should this happen, Collette will make every effort to put you on another departure date. If an alternate cannot be found, a full refund will be made. Air booked through Collette will be protected. We cannot be held responsible for penalties incurred if you have secured your own air.

Can I make changes to my reservation? Should you decide to change your reservation after initial booking, a handling fee of \$25 per transaction will be charged. A change of tour date, tour itinerary or passenger name, within the guidelines of the cancellation policy, will be treated as a cancellation and regular cancellation fees may apply.

Revisions to air tickets are subject to the rules and regulations of the airline. See our Cancellation Policy for more details.

Tour Pacing

How can I be best prepared for the pacing and physical requirements on a Collette tour? Tour pacing varies by itinerary, and each destination's sightseeing and activities are unique. Pacing is subject to personal interpretation. At Collette, we do include the best a destination has to offer, enhancing your overall tour experience. For overnight pacing of a tour, please refer to the "Where You'll Stay" section on each tour page. This describes the number of nights you will stay in each hotel during your tour. Please visit our website for full day by day itinerary information.

The Tour Activity Level Ranking is featured on each tour itinerary. The definition of each activity level is listed here. If you have additional questions regarding a specific tour, please inquire at time of reservation. For your comfort, we recommend packing comfortable walking shoes so you can fully enjoy every aspect of your tour.

Level 1: At a very leisurely pace, this tour involves minimal physical activity, such as climbing some stairs, boarding a motorcoach, and walking from the hotel reception area to hotel rooms and dining areas.

Level 2: This tour requires average physical activity. You should be in good health, able to climb stairs and walk reasonable distances, possibly over uneven ground and cobblestoned streets.

Level 3: This tour includes moderate physical activity. The itinerary blends some longer days with shorter days and more leisure time. Walking tours, as well as walking slightly longer distances, up stairs, or on uneven walking surfaces should be expected.

Level 4: To truly experience the program and destination, you need to be able to participate in physical activities such as longer walking tours, walking over uneven terrain, climbing stairs and periods of standing. Some of the touring days may be longer, with select included activities occurring later in the evening.

Level 5: This tour is very active, requiring participants to be physically fit to fully enjoy all the experiences. This itinerary has more strenuous activities which may include such things as: extensive walking tours, transfers over uneven and dusty terrain, high altitudes, early morning departures, late night activities, or extreme temperatures. All conditions do not apply to all days, so please read the itinerary carefully and speak to one of our travel counsellors to determine if this tour is right for you. We recommend this program to individuals who are physically fit. Unfortunately, this tour is not appropriate for individuals who use either walkers or wheelchairs. If this trip is not ideally suited for you, our travel counsellors can help determine the perfect trip for you.

Transfers

Are airport and hotel transfers available? Roundtrip airport-to-hotel transfers are provided for all passengers who purchase airfare through Collette. These transfers do not apply to pre- and post-night stays. Passengers who do not purchase airfare through Collette can purchase arrival and departure transfers from Collette. Some restrictions may apply. All transfers leave at prescheduled times.

Are airport transfers available for pre/post hotel stays?

All passengers who purchase pre and post hotel nights through Collette may also purchase transfers to/from the airport and the pre or post hotel. Please inquire at time of booking.

What is Roundtrip Home to Airport Sedan Service? It's your ticket to and from the airport. This service is available for all air-inclusive tour bookings. This personalized service is included when you reside within a 100 km radius of the airport.* Please confirm at time of booking. Not valid on group travel.

Land Rates

Land rates are on a per person, double occupancy unless otherwise noted. Availability of departures at the prices noted in the brochure is limited. Government taxes and fees are additional. The land price includes those land based items delineated as included in the package itinerary and does not include any other items such as air travel, airline fees, airport or departure taxes, transfers, visas, customary end of trip gratuities for your tour manager, driver, local guides, hotel housekeepers, cruise ship waitstaff, and any incidental charges.

Payments

Land Package Deposit

- A \$250 non-refundable deposit is due with your land only reservation.

Should you decide to purchase our Travel Protection Plan, you must do so at the time of booking. Payment of this Plan includes the Pre-Departure Cancellation Fee Waiver which protects you from penalties in the event you have to cancel your entire tour package for any reason up to the day prior to departure (see Part A for more details). If you originally purchased non-refundable airline tickets, Part B of the Travel Protection Plan may provide a refund for the airline tickets, taxes, or fees in the event of a cancellation for a covered reason (see Part B for more details).

Final Payment

Revision Fees

Upon receipt of your itinerary, you must review it and report any discrepancies to Collette immediately in order to avoid any supplier incurred penalties. A handling fee of \$25.00 per transaction will be assessed for any change or revision made to a reservation. A change of departure date within 11 months of the departure date will be treated as a cancellation, and cancellation charges will apply.

Cancellation Charges

Cancellations of confirmed bookings and transfers to new travel dates will result in penalties and fees assessed by travel suppliers. If you need to transfer or cancel for any reason prior to tour departure, the following cancellation fees will be assessed on your land or cruise product. Air is 100% non-refundable once paid in full. If canceled prior to being paid in full, the following cancellation fees will also apply to air.

- 90 - 61 days prior to departure: 50% of total price
- 60 - 31 days prior to departure: 85% of total price
- 30 - 0 days prior to departure: 100% of total price

Galapagos & Antarctica:

- More than 120 days prior to departure: non-refundable deposits will be retained.
- 120 - 90 days prior to departure: 60% of total price
- 89 - 0 days prior to departure: 100% of total price

Oberammergau

- More than 120 days prior to departure – a non-refundable deposit will be retained.
- 120 - 91 days prior to departure - 75% of total price
- 90 days - 0 days prior to departure - 100% of total price

Upon cancellation of transportation or travel services where you, the client, are not at fault and have not cancelled in violation of these terms and conditions, you will be refunded 100%.

Airfare

Your rates are subject to change until paid in full. Seats are limited and may not be available on every flight or departure date.

Travel Conditions

Door to Door Transfer Service

Return door to door transfers are offered up to 100 kilometers from most major Canadian gateways with the purchase of an air-inclusive tour.
