How does the CIBT Entry Guide work?

The tool is easy to use – simply input your country of departure, the country of your passport, and your destination and the tool returns clear information on testing and travel requirements for the chosen destination. This tool is continually updated by a dedicated team and can be relied upon for the latest testing and travel requirements.

How do I find out what is required for me to enter my destination?

Once you input your information as mentioned above, please refer to the “Entry Restrictions” and “Entry and Health Requirements” sections of the page.

If your travel plans involve connecting flights in Europe, the countries you will transit through may have different requirements for entry – including testing, vaccination, and masking – that differ from those of your destination. Please make sure to check entry guides for all transit countries outlined in the “Transit Restriction” section of the CIBT Entry Guide.

How do I find out what is required for me to return to the U.S.?

- Entry Restrictions:** Entry is allowed for nationals and residents of EU and EEA member states, Andorra, San Marino, Monaco and Vatican City. Entry from third countries is permitted for compelling reasons only. The entry restriction for third country nationals does not apply to the following categories of travellers: Healthcare workers, healthcare.
- Entry & Health Requirements:** All travellers arriving from a EU or Schengen country that is on the [green list](#) can enter Croatia if they hold a EU Digital COVID Certificate. Those who do not possess such.
- In-country Experience:** Face masks are mandatory in public transport and enclosed public spaces. Most offices, factories, restaurants and stores are open with social distancing measures in.
- Transit Restrictions:** Transit is allowed if the traveller does not leave the airport transit zone and travels to a destination country that will admit them within 92 hours of arrival in Croatia. Transiting.
- Re-Entry Requirements:** All travellers returning to the United States by air must provide a negative, viral COVID-19 test result taken no more than 3 days prior to departure. Viral tests include a Nucleic Acid Test (PCR) test.
